The CICC is the oldest Christian school conference in Indiana, dating back to the 1986-87 season. The following five schools were charter members: Colonial Christian, Eagledale Christian (now Crosspointe Christian), Heritage Hall Christian, Indiana Christian Academy and Suburban Baptist (now Suburban Christian). Conference membership peaked at 12 schools in the 1999-2000 season.

For years Baptist Academy (now Central Christian) of Indianapolis was among the top teams in the conference. Baptist Academy left for the IHSAA in 2009. Another former CICC school, Faith Christian (Lafayette), joined them in 2011 after three years in the Indiana Christian State Tournament (now ICSAA). Other former members included Chapel Heights Academy (closed in 1992), Chapel Hill Christian, Temple Christian (Connersville, left the conference in 2002) and Terre Haute Christian (left the conference in 2008).

Currently, seven schools compete in the Central Indiana Christian Conference. In alphabetical order these schools include the following: Colonial Christian (Indianapolis), Cornerstone Baptist (Indianapolis), Crosspointe Christian (Indianapolis), Heritage Hall Christian (Muncie), Indiana Christian Academy (Anderson), Suburban Christian (Greenwood) and Tabernacle Christian (Martinsville). All seven schools belong to the Indiana Association of Christian Schools (IACS). Cornerstone Baptist played in Division II in 2018 while the rest competed in Division I. Tabernacle Christian won both the conference and the IACS Division I State Championship in 2018, repeated in 2019 and made it three in a row in 2020. Crosspointe Christian tied Tabernacle with a 9-1 conference mark in 2019-20.
