Conference History

The Mid-Central Christian Conference (MCCC), composed of schools from Northwest Indiana and Northeast Illinois, opened play in the 1974-75 season. The conference had up to eight teams in its two seasons of existence.

At the end of both seasons, the MCCC held a conference tournament at Hammond Baptist. The hosts won in 1975 while Baptist Academy prevailed in 1976.

Following the 1975-76 season, Baptist Academy left for the Metropolitan Independent Schools Conference (MISC) in Central Indiana. The MCCC disbanded; however, three schools, Calumet Baptist, Grace Baptist of South Bend and Hammond Baptist joined with new school Landmark Christian of Michigan City to form the Hoosier Christian Conference in time for the 1976-77 season.
