### Conference History

Rich Bafia of Hoosier Boys Town founded the Southlake Athletic Conference in 1999. One reason he started the conference was "not just to showcase (Hoosier Boys Town, later Campagna Academy) but also other athletes (at other conference schools)."

Of the six founding schools, Covenant Christian, Portage Christian and South Haven Christian all competed in the ACSI State Tournament at the end of the season. Covenant was a new school in 1999 and did not compete in varsity boys basketball until the 2001-2002 season. Hoosier Boys Town became Campagna Academy in 2001.

Although information about conference champions is unknown, it is known that Hoosier Boys Town and Covenant Christian both enjoyed some success in the conference. The conference ceased to exist in 2002 or 2003, possibly after Campagna became a charter school.
