Conference History

According to an article on the Tippecanoe Tornados in the Lafayette Journal and Courier in 2007, the homeschool team, two other homeschool organizations and a few Christian schools formed the State Line Christian Conference (SLCC) that year. The Tornados won the regular-season and tournament titles that first year.

While the conference had eight members in the 2008-2009 season, that season would be the last for the SLCC. Holy Cross closed its doors at the end of the school year, and Covington Christian and John Paul II Catholic discontinued varsity sports. John Paul II Catholic ceased to exist at the end of the 2016 school year and Zion's Hill Baptist has also closed.

Today, the three homeschool teams are still active in the Indiana Christian Basketball Alliance (ICBA) while Lighthouse Christian is ending a long run in the Indiana Christian Schools Athletic Associatio (ICSAA) as the Lions prepare to join the IHSAA for the 2020-2021 season.
